BTQ AT THE FOOD BANK

On Thursday, July 27th, Our Monday Night Fellowship, Big Theological Questions group took 7 people to the Oklahoma Regional Food Bank for their Rock-n-Box Karaoke night. We filled bags for the Backpack program for Oklahoma school children. At

the end of the night, we had packaged 6,412 pounds of food, supplying 1,710 backpacks worth, for a total of 5,344 meals! We even sang a few songs while we were at it! Over all it was a great night of fellowship, service, and fun!



WHIZ KIDS

Western Oaks Christian Church has reached out to Southern Hills to see if we might be willing to help with Whiz Kids. Western Oaks Christian Church partners with Western Oaks Elementary School to provide one on one tutoring in reading with a number of children through the Whiz Kids program.

From Western Oaks:

We pick them up from school on Mondays at 3:00 pm and bring them to church for a hearty meal. There is a community time to highlight their achievements as well as a Club Time to tell Bible stories and share the message of God's great love. Then tutors spend 45 minutes to an hour reading and listening to the children read and helping them to improve their reading ability. This event has been more than a blessing to the children, it blesses each one of us involved in the program.

However, we can't do this alone. There is a waiting list of children who are struggling to learn to read and desperately want to learn. They just need

someone willing to give a couple hours each Monday from 3:00 till 5:30 to spend time helping them. We can even be a little flexible on the time if you can't arrive until 3:30 or a little later this is the time the kids are being picked up and fed.

The greatest need is to have dedicated tutors to work with these children. A secondary need is transportation to pick them up from school and then to take them home after Whiz Kids. We always pair our tutors up to transport them home which gives tutors an opportunity to meet parents and become familiar with the students home life. We currently have one bus that we can transport 13 students at a time.

We greatly look forward to the possibility of partnering with Southern Hills Christian Church to continue to provide this great service to these children. If you are interested in helping in this important ministry please contact Western Oaks at (405) 789-8812.
