MATS FOR THE HOMELESS PROJECT



People of all ages work together to make sleeping mats.

The making of the mats out of used plastic shopping bags, is not hard, but does require investment of time and busy hands. The bags are prepared by cutting strips and joining the strips and rolling them into balls called "PLARN" (PLastic yARN). The Plarn is then crocheted or woven into mats.

If you would like to help, we still need clean plastic shopping bags, which you may drop off at the church. You may also like to attend one of the "Plarn Workshops" scheduled on the church calendar (Bring your own scissors, please). Plarn Workshops are held most Monday nights at 6:30 in Boka Keene. We plan to meet all Monday evenings in July, as well as Wednesday, July 11 at noon.
