## UPDATE ON VISION TASK FORCE SURVEY

We want to again thank you for the generous outpouring of your hearts in response to our recent survey. We know you are eager to hear about the results and want to know how we are going to proceed with all the information you have given us. This article is the first of multiple ways and opportunities you will have, in the near future, to learn more about the survey results and our next steps together.

You far exceeded our expectations! Ninety-seven surveys were included in the analysis, and the formal report was delivered to the Vision Task Force on 7/30/18. It was then shared in a joint meeting of the Task Force, Leadership Council and Elders on 8/6/18. One topic that was repeated over and over is that we are a church that is passionate about relationships. This theme came through on a number of questions. For example, Question 3 asked why you continue to attend SHCC, and 86% of you said it was because of relationships. Relationships was also a big reason why many have joined SHCC, and relationships (fellowship) was what over 40% of you like most about your Sunday School class.

You also provided great input as to how we can improve in many areas, and one area in particular that kept coming up again, and again was improved communication and more transparency from your leaders. We have heard you. One of our earliest actions will be to hold a special presentation on the

survey results on Sunday, August 26th, in Fellowship Hall, during the Sunday School hour. All ages who participated in the survey are encouraged to attend. A full report of the survey (the same as Leadership Council and the Elders received) will be provided each person during this meeting.

In the meantime, also know that there are activities already happening with the survey results. For example, your great suggestions about how to improve our worship experience have been given to the Worship Convener, your suggestions for how to better market ourselves have been given to the Communications and Technology Convener, and your suggestions for how to be more welcoming were given to the Diaconate Convener. They, along with their respective committees, will be working through your numerous suggestions to see what can be implemented. Please be assured that no one is seeing your actual surveys. Your answers were transcribed into a separate document that removed all demographic data, and were collated by question, so that we could take your comments to heart and respond in action.

If you have any questions before the 8/26 presentation, feel free to contact any member of the Vision Task Force, the Leadership Council or your elder, and, remember to mark your calendars for the special presentation during the Sunday School hour on 8/26.

## INTERFAITH YOUTH TOUR

### September 16, 1:00 - 5:30 pm

Each September, the Oklahoma Conference of Church's Annual Interfaith Youth Tour is held on a Sunday afternoon for hundreds of metro students ages 7th – 12th grade. The young people (with adult leaders) visit houses of worship for different faiths to learn more about each religion. Meeting the leaders, witnessing a worship experience, exploring the facility, and participating in a question & answer session of other faiths helps to build bridges of understanding, friendship, and mutual respect. Charter buses transport the youth and their sponsors to three quite different houses of worship

in the Oklahoma City area. This year, all three stops on the tour are in Edmond - **Edmond Baha'i Center, Islamic Society of Edmond, and First Christian Church of Edmond.**
