I am not trying to bust your bubble, but just think about it. He only wants what is best for each of us.



SINCE YOU ASKED!

Update From the Financial Convener

From time to time I get asked "where are we?" from our congregation at SHCC. So, I would like to give you the information that is typically the most asked for.

Questions I get are:

- How much do we owe on the mortgage?
- What's our budget for the year?
- How can I help?

I want to answer these with our current information, and provide some things that we need to be working for in the future.

First, our current mortgage balance as of January 15, 2020 is at \$250,816. This is great news especially noting that our current

building value is about \$3.5 million. This means that approximately 93% of our entire building is paid for, with only 7% remaining!

Next, our budgeted expenses in 2019 were \$525,983. We made many improvements along the way in 2019, enabling SHCC to reduce the budget for 2020 to \$508,535. This is a reduction of 3%! In 2019, Our \$20.20 (previously the \$13.33 campaign) paid \$5,328 directly to the mortgage principal. This helps to reduce the mortgage principal which further lowers the interest that we pay on the mortgage loan.

Now, what can we all do to help? That's easy! Even though we have reduced our budget target for 2020, There's still a little room to be made up between the pledge totals and the budget number. If you still want to increase your pledge, or have not turned in a pledge to let SHCC know of your commitment, it's not too late! This helps us to better plan for our continued needs and outreach expectations for 2020.

We, here at SHCC, plan to do better at letting everyone know about the first Sunday of each month being the \$20.20 Sunday! We never stopped the \$20.20 campaign, but the message has been lost as we have navigated all the change of the last year and a half. We intend to do better going forward.


