Southern Hills CDC will be closed Thursday, July 4 in honor of Independence Day.







Parent Handbook

Our parent handbook is designed to answer questions you might have as well as make you aware of our policies and procedures. You can view our handbook on our website at www.shcdc.net. Listed below are a few of the highlights:

- No child will be admitted to class without proof of current immunizations.
- TWO WEEKS PAID NOTICE IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO WITHDRAWAL FROM THE PROGRAM.
- Your child must be fever free for 24 hours without medications to come to school. This also applies to nausea, vomitting, and diarrhea.
- Pick up time is 2:35. LATE PICK-UP fees will be assessed.

- Please send your child in comfortable, easy to manage clothing. We require tennis shoes. NO flipfops or crocs please. Shoes need to be safe for running and climbing.
- Please send nutritious lunches and drinks. We ask that you do not send soda or candy. Our experience shows that most children do not eat "Lunchables" and they end up in the trash.
- If you need to add/change a name who can pick up your child, have a new address or phone number, update immunizations, please stop by the office. Our records need to be as up-to-date as possible.
