

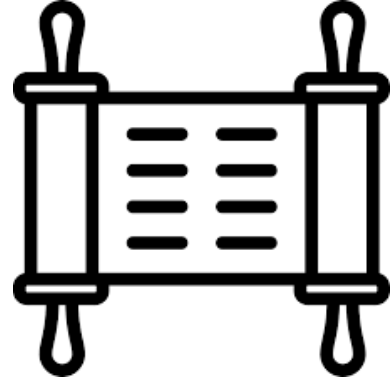

Books of the Law (Torah), Major Characters and Stories

Genesis: Creation, Garden of Eden, Adam & Eve/Cain & Abel, flood & rainbow, Tower of Babel, Abraham & patriarchs (Abraham → Isaac → Jacob), Lot in Sodom & Gomorrah, promised land & circumcision, offering of Isaac, Jacob (Israel) & Esau, 12 sons of Jacob, Joseph, famine & move to Egypt

- Eve (*Gen. 2:21-25; 3; 4-1-2, 25*)
- Daughters of Men (*Gen. 6: 1-4*)

Exodus: Egyptian captivity, Moses, Pharaoh & plagues, red sea crossing, 10 commandments, Aaron and the golden calf, lots of battles, tabernacle, 40 years of wilderness wandering, Moses' death

Numbers: Census, more on the 40-year wanderings, water from rock, Aaron's death, bronze snake, Balaam & angel, Joshua chosen, wars/conquests, cities of refuge

Women:

- Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah and Tirzah (*Num. 27: 1-11*)
- Women of Midian (*Num. 31:9, 15-18, 35*)

Deuteronomy: Census, more law, history recap, Moses' song, death of Moses

Women:

- Women of Heshbon (*Deut. 2:34; 3:6*)
- Daughters passed through the fire (*Deut. 12:31; 18:10*)
