

- 1&2 Chronicles: Genealogies of the Israelites, Additional histories of Saul and David, David's reign, temple-priest-government preparations, David's last days, Solomon's life and reign, Solomon's temple, Queen of Sheba, Solomon's wives/idolatry, history of succeeding kings-idolatries-prophecies (2 Chron10 →) (Note: these books are contemporary with 1&2 Samuel and 1&2 Kings)
- Ezra &Proclamation of Cyrus, return of exiles, rebuilding temple, building wall,<br/>reading & restoration of the law<br/>Prophets Prior to Ezra: Daniel, Ezekiel (prophets of the exile)<br/>Contemporary Prophet(s): Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi

(the book of Esther comes between Ezra & Nehemiah)

While Ruth and Esther are part of the books of history, they will be covered next week.

Note: Women listed are not exclusive. A little over 200 women or groups of women are found in the books of History and the Prophets.
