

Popular Verses from Acts – Revelation

- Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.
- Acts 2:4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
- Acts 2:38 Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Acts 2:41-42 Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.
- Acts 17:11 Now the Berean Jews were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.
- Acts 20:28 Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood.
- Acts 20:7 On the first day of the week we came together to break bread. Paul spoke to the people and, because he intended to leave the next day, kept on talking until midnight.
- Rom 1:16 I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile.
- Rom 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God
- Rom 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ
- Rom 5:8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- Rom 6:3 Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?
- Rom 8:1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus
- Rom 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
- Rom 8:38-39 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Rom 10:13 For, Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.
- Rom 10:17 Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.
- Rom 12:1-2 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God – this is true worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – his good, pleasing and perfect will.
- 1 Cor 2:9 However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived – these things God has prepared for those who love him"
- 1 Cor 6:19-20 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own, you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

- 1 Cor 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to us all. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.
- 1 Cor 10:31 So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.
- 1 Cor 11:23 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread ...
- 1 Cor 12:12 Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ.
- 1 Cor 13:4 ... Love is patient, love is kind...
- 2 Cor 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that everyone may receive what is due them for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.
- 2 Cor 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!
- Gal 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
- Gal 3:26 So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith
- Gal 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, neither male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Gal 5:6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.
- Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness
- Gal 6:2 Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.
- Gal 6:9-10a Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people,
- Eph 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.
- Eph 2:8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God
- Eph 2:10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
- Eph 5:21 Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.
- Phil 1:6 Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
- Phil 1:21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.
- Phil 2:5 In your relationships with one another, have the same attitude of mind Christ Jesus had:
- Phil 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
- Phil 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
- Phil 4:8 Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things.
- Phil 4:13 I can do all this through him who gives me strength.
- Col 1:16a For in him all things were created:
- Col 2:12 Having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through your faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.
- Col 3:1 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.

- Col 3:16-17 Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
- 1Thes 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.
- 1Thes 5:16-18 Rejoice always; Pray continually; Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
- 2Thes 3:13 And as for you, brothers and sisters, never tire of doing what is good.
- 1Tim 3:5 If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church?
- 1Tim 4:12 Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.
- 1Tim 6:6-7 But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it.
- 1Tim 6:10a For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil.
- 2Tim 1:7 For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.
- 2Tim 2:15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.
- 2Tim 3:16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness
- Tit 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people.
- Heb 4:12 For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
- Heb 4:14 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess.
- Heb 10:24 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds
- Heb 11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
- Heb 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
- Heb 12:1-2 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Heb 12:4 Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.
- Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.
- Js 1:2 Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds
- Js 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.
- Js 1:17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.
- Js 1:22 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.
- Js 1:27 Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.

- Js 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord.
- Js 5:16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.
- 1Pet 1:23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.
- 1Pet 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
- 1Pet 4:10 Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.
- 1Pet 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
- 2Pet 1:5-8 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2Pet 3:8-9 But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.
- 1Jn 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.
- 1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
- 1Jn 4:7-8 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.
- 3Jn 1:4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.
- Rev 1:8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty."
- Rev 3:20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with them, and they with me.
- Rev 21:4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.
- Rev 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let those who hear say, "Come!" Let those who are thirsty come; and let all who wish take the free gift of the water of life.
